

# Halifax Harvest Days 4-H Poultry Project Rules and Regulations

- 1. Participants must be between the ages of 5 18, as of January 1, 2021 and enroll or be a current participant in Halifax County 4-H.
- 2. Project educational workshop will be held the third Tuesday of each month at 6:30pm at the Halifax Ag Center. The scheduled dates are June 22nd, July 20th, August 17th, and September 21st.
- **3.** Participants are strongly encouraged to attend all of the four workshops. Participating families that attend will receive pertinent information and publications on raising chickens and learn procedures of the project.

# **4.** Divisions:

# a. Standard Poultry Project -

- i. Each participant will receive two or three chicks of the same age but sex undetermined.
- ii. Participants will raise and care for their animals until the Halifax Harvest Days 4-H Poultry Show on October 9, 2021 under the supervision of the guardians and Extension Agents.
- iii. Participants will be given a starter kit if needed but will be responsible for all expenses incurred while raising them (feed, housing, medication, etc.).
- iv. Participants will present one bird they have raised at the Halifax Harvest Days 4-H Poultry Show on <u>Saturday, October 9<sup>th</sup>, 2021</u> at 4-H Rural Life Center. Divisions will be divided according to 4-H ages of Cloverbuds, Juniors and Seniors. A qualified adult or youth will judge the show.
- v. Standard project exhibitors will be asked to share their bird and assist a Rookie Division participant in a showmanship class.
- vi. A 4-H Project Record Book must be completed and turned in to qualify to show at the Harvest Days Show. Record books are due <u>Saturday, October 9, 2021</u> to be on display at the Show.

### b. Rookie Poultry Project –

- **i.** This division is for youth with an interest in the project, but are unable to house birds on their own.
- **ii.** In this division youth do not receive chicks.
- **iii.** Participants will compete at the Halifax Harvest Days 4-H Poultry Show on October 9, 2021 at the 4-H Rural Life Center. They will be assisted by a youth participant from the standard project and will share a bird to exhibit in a Rookie Showmanship Division.
- **iv.** Rookie Participants will complete a poster on a poultry topic they have learned to display at the Harvest Days Show.
- **3.** Entry fees are \$10.00 per participant. Entry fees are due with entry forms. You will be notified when chicks are ready for pick-up / drop-off.
