



## Value-Added Stipend for Small Farmers

North Carolina A&T State University through a fund from the North Carolina Tobacco Trust Fund Commission can provide farmers with a reimbursement of up to \$240 for work completed on the farm or items purchased to promote agritourism or value-added. Some examples would be (1) signage for agritourism or for selling value-added products at a roadside stand or the farmers' market; (2) improvements to a driveway on your farm where customers would drive or park; (3) a special pot to cook apple butter or jam, etc. to sell as value-added products and (4) costs of required certification to produce and sell value-added food products.

Please complete this application and submit it to the address below for **APPROVAL**. Once **APPROVED**, you will be notified via mail, email, or telephone. After **APPROVAL**, you complete the work or purchase the items, submit copies of the receipts, other documentation including photos of the finished work/item so that we can report to the funding agency, North Carolina Tobacco Trust Fund Commission. We will then send you your reimbursement up to \$240. The application will be considered on need and a first come basis.
