# SIMPLE FABRIC BUNTING

- 3 yards double fold bias tape
- fabric strips of different colors
- Fabric pen/erase marker
- matching or contrasting thread.

1

First determine the size and amount of the flags you would like to make - Cut two rectangles of fabric  $1/2$ " wider and taller than the flag size (for each flag) Or use pattern piece for size.

2

Sandwich the two rectangles (RST) - Draw the flag shape on (wrong side) of the rectangle sandwich, accounting for the seam allowances in the measurements.

3

Sew around the flag shape- either on the drawn line, or using a  $1/4$ " seam allowance on the cut angled sides. Trim seam allowance, especially at the point.

Cut out the flag shape- Cutting from the top corners to the center of the bottom side (point).

5

Turn the flag right side out - Use a blunt turning tool to CAREFULLY push out the point of the flag. Press the side seams well. (top stitch if desired) Make as many flags as desired.

Assembling the finished edge of bunting- Open up the two folded sides of the double fold bias tape and slide the flag inside so the top of the flag matches up with the fold line.

7

Finally - refold the bias tape and pin or clip the flag in place. Add the remaining flags, spacing them out as desired. Edge stitch along the open side of the bias tape to close it and secure the tops of the flags inside.
